WHAT IS FAITH PROMISE GIVING?

Faith-promise giving is not just another church pledge.

1. A Faith-promise is simply a covenant between God and the individual. I promise to trust God to give me "extra money" that I can direct to missionary causes. In a sense I am simply making myself a channel through which God can send money to missions. I dare to let God use my faith and my life to bless others on the mission field.
2. The church only helps get the funds to the mission field. There is no attempt to collect the money. This is a promise to God and not the church.
3. Faith-promises do not tie to the local church budget. This is entirely "extra" giving. I have made a pledge to our church which I intend to keep, but this is over and above that. I am not taking money away from the budget to give to missions. I am trusting God for extra money for missions.
4. This is no attempt to give more of my present income. It is an agreement to handle God's money for Him to support missions. As He makes extra money available to me, I make it available for missions. I become God's partner in financing His work.
5. A Faith-promise is a means of growing in faith. When I see how God works in this venture of faith, I learn to trust Him even more in All areas of my life.

HOW TO PRAY FOR YOUR MISSIONARIES

1. Spend time in thanks for your missionaries.
2. Pray for the daily lives of your missionaries.
3. Pray that barriers may be minimized so that the Gospel may go forward.
4. Pray that your missionaries will have wisdom in the use of their time.
5. Pray that the Holy Spirit will lead your missionaries to prepared hearts.
6. Pray for the missionaries children.
7. Pray faithfully for your missionaries.
8. Show interest in the missionaries by writing to them about their work.
9. Pray for more missionaries.
